

Ad Astra Academy Entry Requirements for Elite Sports and Performing Arts Scholars 2021

Ad Astra entry concessions

- A points concession can be given to applicants who have been accepted by the Ad Astra Academy (Elite Sports and Performing Arts Scholars only). The concession is a reduction of 60 points based on the average of the previous three years for each CAO Code¹. However, no applicant will be admitted with a score less than 300 points. Please see table for current year overleaf.
- Applicants must meet general matriculation and programme specific subject requirements.
- The reduction allowed for determining entry to the Professional Masters in Education (which operates on a different points system) will remain at 10%.
- A concession of up to 10% on normal entry requirements may be allowed for other UCD applicants (e.g. graduate, Non-EU, transfer), at the discretion of the relevant Programme Board.

Ad Astra quotas for entry with points concession

- Intake quotas can be set by a Programme Board where the number of Ad Astra places offered for any particular course with points concession, are limited.
- In the event that the number of approved candidates who meet the concession criteria exceeds the quota for a programme, offers will be based on Ad Astra Academy ranking.
- If the quota is not filled, Admissions will make further offers from the approved candidates, in order of ranking, until the quota is filled or the list of approved candidates is exhausted.

Ad Astra entry procedures

- Applicants must apply separately to both the Ad Astra Academy and via the appropriate route for admission to the courses(s).
- Current UCD Ad Astra students, wishing to re-enter Stage 1 of another programme or applying for an internal programme transfer must re-apply to the Ad Astra Academy.
- Applicants may be interviewed.
- Admission to the Academy, does not guarantee admission to UCD as applicants must also meet academic requirements.

Please Note:

• Admission to the Ad Astra Academy cannot be deferred. Therefore, applicants who receive an offer with a points concession, cannot defer their place.

• CAO applicants admitted to the Ad Astra academy after Round 1 offers, will only be considered for courses in later rounds where places remain.

^{*} For Medicine (DN400), no concession applies to the HPAT score Therefore, eligibility will be calculated by adding 60 points to the applicants school-leaving exam points score (this total is capped at 625 points) This score will then be moderated (using the normal formula) and combined with the HPAT score If the resulting score meets the 2021 minimum combined score, the applicant will be deemed eligible for consideration for the places available
